In Grade 9-12 students must:

- Achieve a minimum grade of 3\* or higher in:
  - > English (Language and Literature, Literature or Language Acquisition)
  - A second language (Language and Literature or Language) Acquisition)
  - › Individuals and Societies
  - Science
  - Mathematics
  - > Arts (G9-12) or in Grade 11/12 an additional Science or Individuals and Societies subject

Over four semesters in Grade 9-10 students must:

- Achieve a minimum grade of 3\* or higher in:
  - > Physical and health education

Additional requirements:

- Meet Service as Action (G9&10) and CAS requirements (G11&12)
- Meet school attendance requirements
